In 1973, some 200 Oglala Lakota and American Indian Movement (AIM) activists had seized the few major buildings in town and police had cordoned off the area. The occupation of Wounded Knee had begun. Demanding redress for grievances—some going back more than 100 years—the protesters captured the world's attention for 71 gripping days. The film examines the broad political and economic forces that led to the emergence of AIM in the late 1960s as well as the immediate events.
