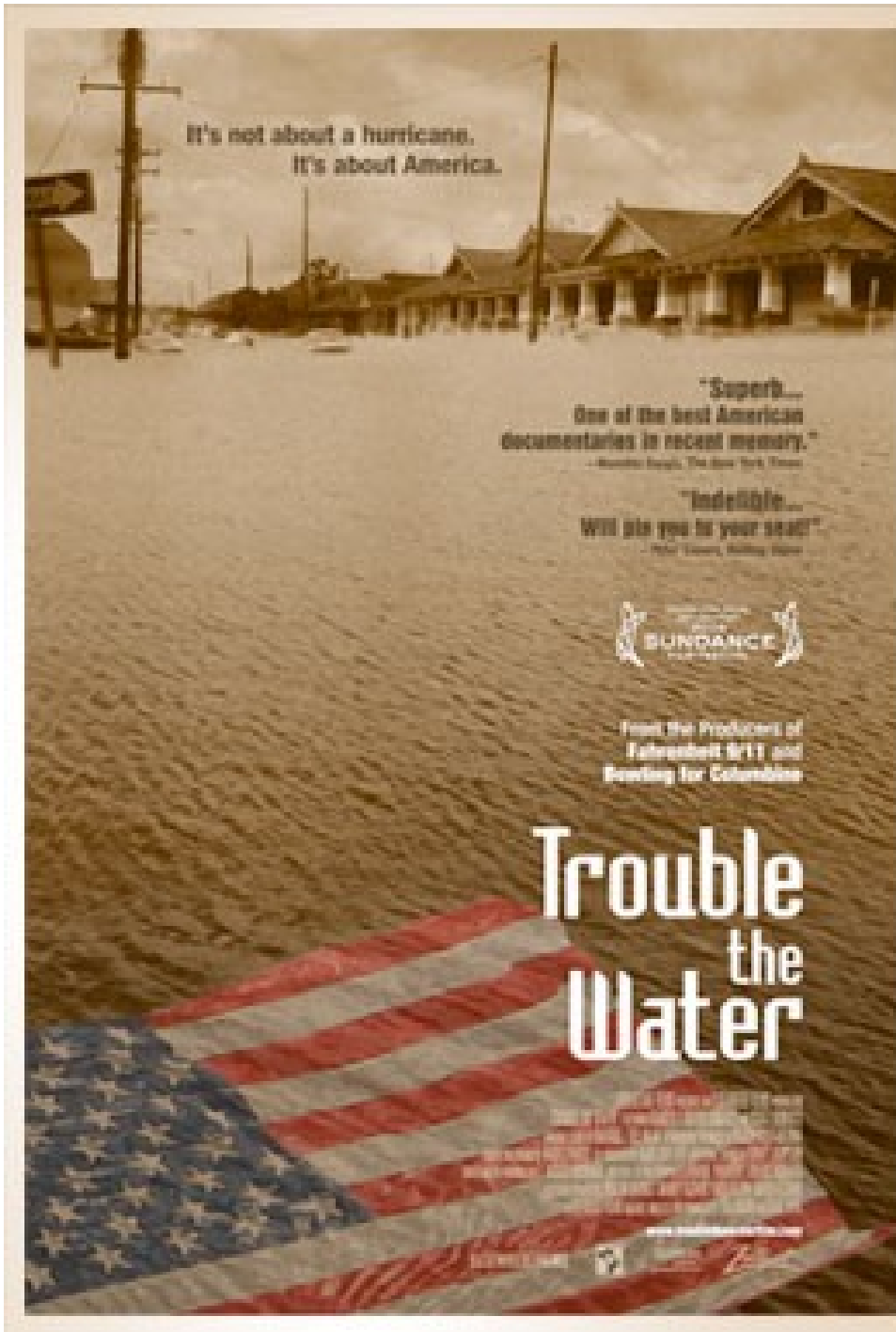
# Trouble the Water
